- Home to Ballet San Jose and Broadway San Jose

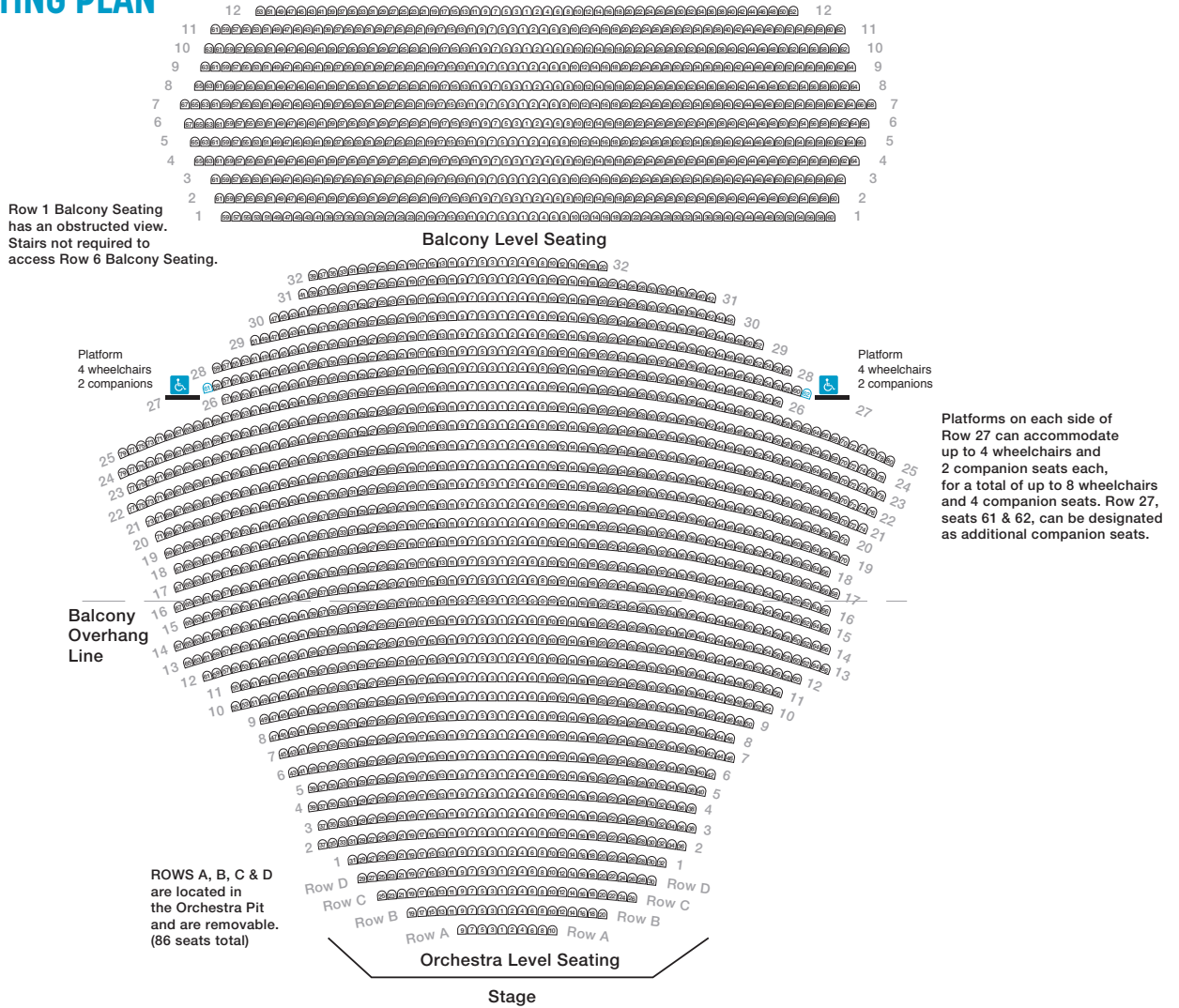
## VENUE SYNOPSIS

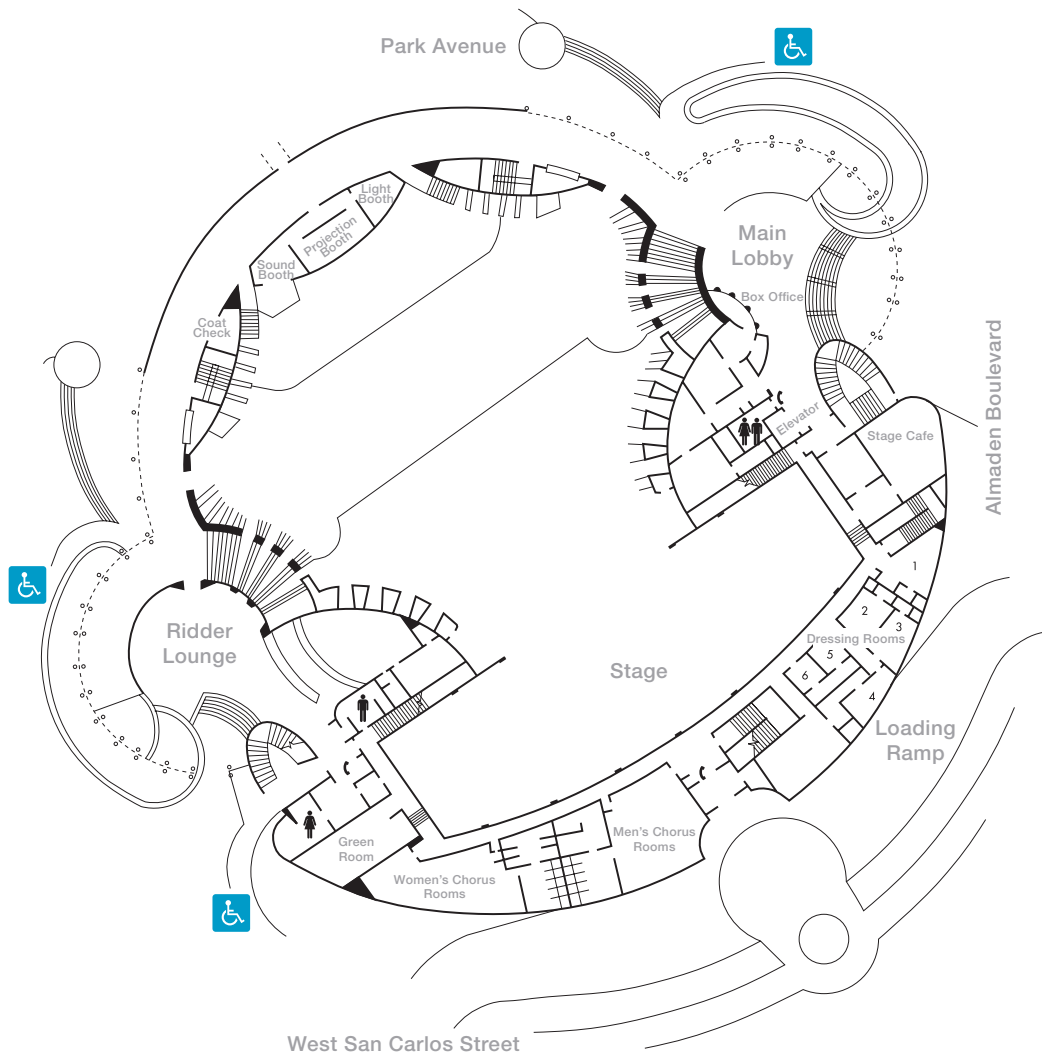
